In 1985 upon graduation from the Aviation Secondary School, BG Pilot Krzysztof Cur began his military career as a cadet at the Air Force Academy in Dęblin, Poland where he completed his studies in 1989 receiving a BSc degree and he was commissioned to 2nd Lieutenant. In 1999 he earned his MA in Pedagogy at the Maria Curie-Skłodowska University in Lublin, Poland.

Since December 2020 he has been serving as a Rector-Commandant of the Polish Air Force University in Deblin.
